\*Because we are credentialed as a specialist, which differs from a traditional Urgent Care or Walk-in Clinic, we recommend that you call ahead or contact your insurance company to verify referral or authorization requirements prior to your arrival to eliminate any unnecessary wait time.



**Q. Do I need to make an appointment to be seen at Florida Orthopaedic Institute's Orthopaedic Urgent Care?**

**A. No appointment is necessary, but calling ahead and registering can save additional time.\* Orthopaedic Urgent Care hours:**  
*Monday-Thursday: 8 AM - 8 PM.*  
*Friday: 8 AM - 4 PM.*  
*Saturday: 8 AM - 3 PM*

**Q. Do you take patients of all ages?**

**A. We accept patients ages two and up.**

**Q. What are the benefits of Florida Orthopaedic Institute's Orthopaedic Urgent Care versus other options?**

**A. You save time and money and will be treated by an orthopaedic provider. Additionally, wait times are typically much shorter than they would be at a traditional urgent care facility or an emergency room.**

**Q. Will my insurance company cover my visit at Florida Orthopaedic Institute's Orthopaedic Urgent Care?**

**A. As with any medical care, it is always recommended that you check with your insurance company to assure coverage.**

**Q. How do I know when to go to Florida Orthopaedic Institute's Orthopaedic Urgent Care instead of scheduling a clinic appointment with the Florida Orthopaedic Institute?**

**A. If you have a sudden injury as the result of an accident, sports, or other intense physical activity, visit our Orthopaedic Urgent Care center. These injuries include, but are not limited to, sprains and strains, broken bones, dislocations, large cuts, swollen or painful joints, and any sudden or severe pain.**

**Q. Do you accept Workers' Compensation?**

**A. Yes, the highly trained and skilled providers and staff at Florida Orthopaedic Institute are committed to helping all Workers' Compensation patients get back on the job as quickly and safely as possible. There are specific requirements. In order to treat Workers' Compensation through our Urgent Care, we must have authorization from the claims examiner prior to treatment. Please report work related accidents to your employer immediately. Advise your employer that you would like to come to Florida Orthopaedic Institute Urgent Care. They can then contact our dedicated Workers' Compensation team @ 813-971-3304 with a first report of Injury and authorization for your urgent care visit.**

**Q. If I need physical therapy after my Urgent Care, is that available?**

**A. Yes, we provide physical therapy services on-site next door to the Urgent Care facility.**
